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# SICK CHILDREN POLICY

#### REMINDER: AGREEMENT REQUIRED BY THE STATE

When my child is ill (has a temperature, diarrhea, vomiting or a communicable disease) it is understood that he/she will not come to school or will be sent home.

Flu seasons are unpredictable. Although widespread flu activity usually occurs every year, the timing, severity, and duration of it depend on many factors, including which flu viruses are spreading, the number of people who are susceptible to the flu viruses that are spreading, and how similar vaccine viruses are to the flu viruses that are causing illness. The timing of flu activity can vary from season to season.

#### **Best Precautions:**

Wash your hand frequently to avoid spreading germs. Sanitize areas around you often. Stay home when you have a fever or vomiting. Optional: Vaccinations can be preventative.

### **Reporting Child Sick Days**

Please remember to report first thing in the morning if your child is sick and will not be attending school that day.

Also, please do not send sick children to school. Just notify the office by 8:30 a.m., so that we can mark it as an excused absence, NOT in the afternoon or the next day.

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


