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#### What tests do IScGKC students take?

Our students take the following tests: <u>NWEA MAP</u> tests for Kindergarteners-10th graders (Fall & Spring tests) <u>End-of-Course</u> tests for 8th-10th graders (Spring tests)

#### What is a NWEA MAP test?

NWEA MAP Growth is a nationally normed, standardized achievement test which measures what students know and informs what they're ready to learn next by using a computer adaptive test that adjusts to the ability and knowledge of the student.

#### What is a gifted MAP score?

The gifted identification process is lengthy and can vary from student to student. It takes the entire school year to complete sometimes and may even lead into the next school year. The process begins with a qualifying Fall MAP score of **90% or higher**.

#### How did IScGKC students do on NWEA MAP test scores?

Our students did very well in the MAP tests. We are seeing a big improvement from the last couple of years in all grades. Your child's test scores were sent out this month with them. Please check their backpacks.

#### What is an End-of-Course test?

End of Course (EOC) Assessment means a statewide general assessment administered to high school students at the completion of select high school courses to measure student achievement of the content standards for the content area. We test with Algebra I, Algebra II, English I, English II, Biology, Physical Science and Personal Finance.

#### Do other educational institutions use these test scores for acceptance into their programs?

Yes, some educational institutions look at the EOC test scores for acceptance into their institution or college, especially for Algebra I. Some institutions or colleges even offer scholarships based on the student's scores.

#### How did IScGKC students do on End-of-Course test scores?

The official scores will not be available until August sometime, but we did receive the raw scores, and they are very good. We have many in the Advanced and Proficient level categories. Last year the majority of our students scored in the Proficient level in both Algebra I and English I & II. We are very proud of all of our students.

Students worked hard taking their Algebra I End-of-Course test. The EOC tests were given the week of May 8, 2023.

We have received the raw test scores, and we are now waiting for the official, final test scores which are to be sent in August.

As we converted the raw test scores for the students, the results were very promising. We had many students with scores in the **Proficient and Advanced level for Algebra I.** Because students who want to participate in the state A+ Program must be in these two levels, many of our students will now be eligible.

Other subject area tests are also looking very good as we convert their raw test scores into their appropriate performance level.

Students have taken English I (9th Graders), English II (10th Graders), Algebra I (8th, 9th, 10th Graders), Algebra II (9th, 10th Graders), and Physical Science (8th Graders).
