SICK CHILDREN POLICY

REMINDER: AGREEMENT REQUIRED BY THE STATE

When my child is ill (has a temperature, diarrhea, vomiting or a communicable disease) it is understood that he/she will not come to school or will be sent home.

Flu seasons are unpredictable. Although widespread flu activity usually occurs every year, the timing, severity, and duration of it depend on many factors, including which flu viruses are spreading, the number of people who are susceptible to the flu viruses that are spreading, and how similar vaccine viruses are to the flu viruses that are causing illness. Wash your hand frequently to avoid spreading germs. Sanitize areas around you often.

We will return on April 26th. Since this will be the last ten days of Ramadan, it will give us time to reflect, increase our knowledge, and become closer to Allah.


